**CCC** (Cargo Carrying Capacity) is equal to GVWR minus each of the following: U/VW, full fresh (potable) water weight (including water heater), and full LP gas weight.

To help determine travel trailer customers estimate this total weight, our Gross Vehicle Weight Ratings reflect the actual maximum weight of the trailer when fully loaded for camping.
