CAMPGROUND RULES

Campers must be 21 years or older to reserve camping sites.

Registration is done at the bar – by the hostess station area or ask bartender

Early check in prior to 3pm is possible for an extra fee. (Please ask about this)

QUIET TIME: 10pm to 7am

1. No more than 1 tent per site (*if we find more than 1 tent per site, you will be charge for the additional tent*)
No more than 1 trailer per site (if we find more than 1 trailer per site, you will be charge for the additional trailer) No combination of trailer and tents (if we find this you will be charged according.)
2. Curfew for those less than 18 years of age to be back at their campsites is 10pm.
Parents are held responsible for the actions of their children.
3. When walking the roads, please use the side of the roads
4. Children should not be playing in the roads, parking area, gardens & open landscaping areas.
5. Children are not allowed on roads with any type of motorize/battery type play toys/vehicles
6. No Children are allowed in bar without parents.
7. No more than 2 cars per camping site
8. Campfires may only be made inside the provided fire pits & must remain within the ring provided. NO Bonfires are allowed!
9. Fires must be extinguish upon departure or as you retire for the night.
10. Firewood is for sale at the bar \$5.00 bundle or 2/\$8.00
11. No scavenging for firewood permitted or cutting trees & underbrush
12. Nailing into trees is NOT permitted
13. No Dumping waste water (including dishwater) on the ground. Please use dumping stations up at bar parking lot. Do not dump this water in the bathrooms either.
14. No Fireworks are allowed
15. No Firearms are permitted (this includes BB guns, pellet guns, air-soft guns as well as bow and arrows).

16. Checking out time is Noon – Late Check is possible for fee (\$10.00 charge if you wish to stay a few hours more, due to nice weather and want to enjoy more time)
If staying overnight – then another night of camping is charge. See bartender

VEHICLES

1. Our roads are private property, not public streets.
2. Speed limit is 5mph and will be enforced (if car is leaving dust trail YOU are GOING to FAST)
3. Trucks over 3 tons are NOT permitted – park up by bar (we must be notified of this)
4. No ATV's are allowed
5. No Golf Carts to be brought in for weekend camping

NOISE

1. Please keep all radios, stereos, TV's boom boxes and any other electrics at a reasonable sound level. If you are not at your camping area, your audio equipment should be turned off.
2. Excessive noise, drunkenness, foul language, immoral and illegal conduct will not be tolerated. Police will be notified and you will be asked to leave with no refunds

PETS

1. Must be on leash at all times.
2. Your pet should not be left unattended
3. No exotic or unusually animals allowed in park.
4. Owners are responsible for their pet's droppings – please PICK them UP.
5. No pets are allowed in any park buildings, pool area, children's playgrounds, gardens or vacant lots.
6. Pets must be of good nature with strangers.
7. Any incident between a person and your pet must be reported to the park owners. Owners of the pet will be held responsible for any actions or charges from these incidents.
8. Any incident between your dog and another dog in the park must be reported. Owners will be held responsible for any actions or charges from these incidents. Police could be called and involved in these incidents.

GARBAGE

1. Please take all garbage to dumpsters upon checking out/leaving campgrounds
2. Dumpster are located up front across the parking lot from bar. Please put in right dumpster.
3. Recycling laws require all aluminum, tin, glass, #1 & #2 plastic be clean & put into the appropriate dumpster bins upfront.

POOL RULES

Note:

- No lifeguards are provided. It is your responsibility to watch your children.
 - Parents are responsible for the actions of their children
 - No swimming alone allowed
 - Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
 - Oakwood Campsites Bar & Grill, LLC (AKA Oakwood Bar, Restaurant, Campgrounds) assumes no responsibility for personal injury or death.
1. Pool Hours are 10am to 8pm (unless we are hosting a private event)
 2. Regular swimwear must be worn at all times (*shorts cannot be used for swimming*)

3. Children in diapers – *please make sure they have a swim diaper on. (Little Acorn now carries them)*
4. Absolutely no diving is permitted
5. No carry-ins allowed
6. No spitting, or urinating in the pool
7. No inflated toys, inner tubes, noodles, balloons, etc. permitted in pool.
8. No glass of any sort allowed by the pool, all drinks must be in plastic ware.
See staff in bar area if you need a plastic glass.
9. No wet suits allowed in either bar areas. Please make sure you are dried off completely, which means no water dripping from your suits what so ever.
10. Bathroom facilities – across from “Little Acorn” please use that door and those bathrooms when swimming in pool. Do not use “Deck” Entrance to come in from pool area when Wet! *(When suits are wet and you come into bar, you are making floors wet, which is hazard for those that are in the bar area and moving around that are not swimming.)*

Please help us keep pool area clean by picking up after yourself. Put all trash, cigarettes, cups, etc., in provided containers. Please put all tables and chairs back where you found them. Please pick up after your children! And help keep the bathrooms clean and dry too!
