

CAMPGROUND RULES

Must be 21 years of age to camp (Rates are base on maximum of 6 people combination of adults & children)

QUIET TIME 11pm to 7am

Check in Time is 3pm - Check out Time is Noon

Early Check in available—must let us know prior to day coming in cost is \$10.00

Late Check out available—must let us know prior to day checking out—cost is \$10.00

No more than 1 tent or trailer per site. If we find that you do you will be charge accordingly.

Curfew for those under the age of 18 to be back at camp is 10pm. (Parents are held responsible for the actions of their children.

Quiet time is 11pm - Keep all radios, stereos, TV's, boom boxes and any other electronics sound level down. At night sounds travels farther than you know, so please keep things to a whisper if sitting

If you are not at campsite - all audio equipment should be turned off.

Excessive noise, drunkenness, foul language, immoral, illegal conduct will not be tolerated.

Police can and will be called and you will be asked to leave with no refunds.

All garbage to be taken to dumpsters upon checking out/leaving campgrounds or take home with you. Dumpsters are upfront by parking lot in fenced area, but not locked. If garbage or damages are done to campsite, you can be charged for clean up.

Roads are private property—not public streets. Speed limit is 5mph. Please drive carefully & WATCH out for children.

No more than 2 cars per camping site—keep them on your site only.

No ATV's allowed

No one under the age of 16 to drive a golf cart

Walking roads—please walk the sides

Children should not be playing in roads, parking area, gardens

Children are not allowed on roads with any type of motorize/battery type toys/vehicles

Pets must be on leashed at all times.

No more than 1 pet per site.

Pets must be of good nature with people & other pets

Pet should not be left unattended outside while you are gone.

No pets in any of the buildings including bathrooms or in pool area

Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pet—which means their doggie doo doo.

Owners are responsible for any incident between their pets and a person or another pet.

Any incident must be reported to Management

Campfires may only be made inside the provided fire pit & must remain within the ring provided.

No bonfires

Fires extinguish upon departure of site or as you retire for the night.

Firewood for sale at Tiki Bar –Bar area

No cutting Or scavenging for firewood— branches, trees, or underbrush

Nailing into trees is NOT PERMITTED

POOL RULES Hours are 10am to 8pm (unless we are hosting a private event)

Note:

1. No lifeguards are provided. It is your responsibility to watch your children.
2. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children under the age of 18.
3. No swimming ALONE allowed
4. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
5. K-Party Wild Rose Campground, LLC (DBA Oakwood Campsites Bar & Grill) assumes no responsibility for personal injury or death.
6. Regular swim-wear must be worn at all times (*shorts cannot be used for swimming*)
7. Children in diapers – *please make sure they have a swim diaper on. (Little Acorn now carries them)*
8. Absolutely no diving is permitted
9. No carry-ins allowed - bar or Tiki bar has items for sale.
10. No spitting, or urinating in the pool
11. No inflated toys, inner tubes, noodles, balloons, etc. permitted in pool.
12. No dogs allowed in pool area.
13. No glass of any sort allowed by the pool, all drinks must be in plastic ware.
See staff in bar or if Tiki Bar is open if you need a plastic glass.
14. *No wet suits allowed indoor bar area. Please make sure you are dried off completely, which means no water dripping from your suits what so ever. (Wet suits will make our bar floors slippery and hazard for others in the bar and our wait staff.)*
14. *Bathroom facilities—across from the “Tiki Bar” please use this door to enter into the bathrooms in this hall area when you when you are using the pool.*

Please help us keep pool area clean by picking up after yourself. Put all trash, cigarettes, cups etc in provided containers. Please pick up after your children! And help keep the bathrooms clean and dry too! We appreciate if you put all tables and chairs back where you found them.
